

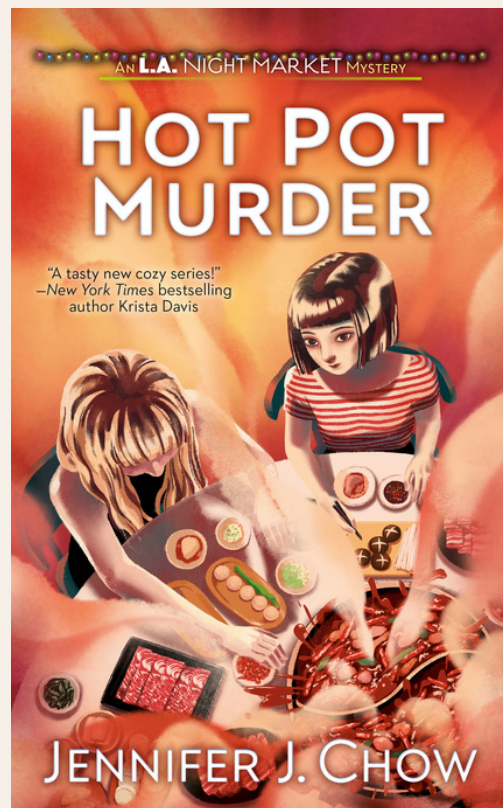

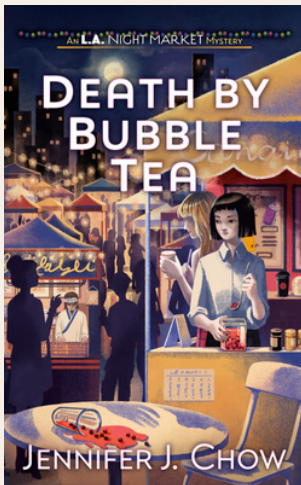
## MYSTERIES
